THE PLAN

Increase the number of club rides by

- reducing the average time for a Ride Leader to select a ride to lead
- providing good ride choices for new RLs who are unfamiliar with our tour library
- providing an increasing number of popular ride choices for ride leaders on consistent days/times at popular start points



WHAT IS MAF RIDE PLANNING?

The RPC publication of proposed (leaderless) rides from which Ride Leaders can choose to lead.



WHY DO THIS?

- Potentially creates a more robust schedule
- New Ride Leaders who are unfamiliar with the tour library can easily volunteer to lead popular proposed rides.
- Experienced Ride Leaders who want to lead rides but don't have the time to research the tour library can simply select to lead proposed rides.



HOW DO WE DO IT?

- The RPC creates Proposed Rides on the schedule
- Only Ride Leaders can see and sign up to lead the Proposed Rides.
- Nothing else is changed:
 - Ad Hoc rides can still be scheduled by Ride Leaders
 - Any club member can see and sign up for any ride that has a leader.

The number of ride sign-ups may be limited at the ride leader's discretion and if it is limited, you will see a number in parenthesis after the tour name which indicates the number of sign-ups remaining. Ride Leaders: Type Scheduled or Proposed in the search box to see only scheduled or only proposed rides.
